30. Is attendance mandatory?

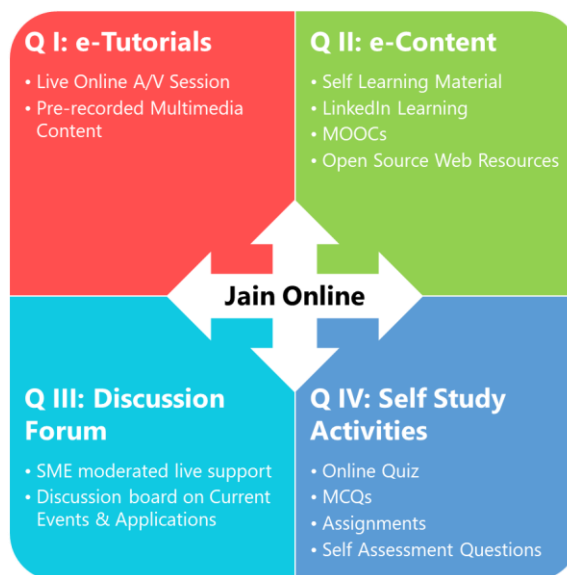

In electronic/digital form on the Learning Management System (LMS)

34. What is a Learning Management System?

It is a platform (software) through which program delivery and administration is managed.

35. Is Internet connection required?

Only to login into LMS and to download content

36. When will a learner get access to LMS?

Immediately after admission is approved.

37. Is there any additional fee to be paid to use the LMS?

No. However, a nominal amount will be charged for usage beyond the program duration.

38. Can a learner interact with faculty? When and how?

Yes. Directly during the live online sessions and through discussion forums and chat in offline mode on the LMS.

39. How will a learner know his batchmate?

Through groups created on the LMS

40. What is Self Learning Material (SLM)?

Study material

41. Will study material be provided?

e-copy will be available on the LMS

42. Can the e-content be downloaded?

Yes

45. How will examination be conducted?

Online Proctored Exam. Proctored – Webcam monitored

Twice (Both odd and even semester)

Yes. A desktop or laptop computer with a working webcam & microphone facility.

Continuous Assessment: 30 Marks (Internal marks)

End Semester Examination: 70 Marks

53. What does Continuous Assessment comprise?

3 Assignments (MCQ pattern) – 1st and 2nd are optional, 3rd is Mandatory

54. Is there some minimum marks to be secured in continuous assessment?

55. What is the question paper format for End Semester Examination?

Subjective (Essay type, 20 marks) and Objective (MCQ, 50 marks) questions

56. What is the minimum passing marks requirement?

UG – 40%

PG – 40%

57. Will Marks Card be issued?

A consolidated Marks Card will be issued at the end of the Program.

58. Will a provisional marks statement be issued after each exam?

Yes. A learner will have to raise a request for the same.

59. When will Degree certificate be issued?

Degree Certificate will be issued during/after the annual convocation.
